## Rocky Railway Crossing

## **Supplies**

- carpet tube
- ▶ tape measure
- black bulletin board paper or black paint and brush
- lacking tape (if you are using paper to wrap the carpet tube)
- ▶ railroad crossing signs from the Giant Decorating Poster Pack\*
- scissors
- ▶ white foam core sheet (32"x40")
- ▶ hot glue gun and glue sticks
- > spray adhesive
- ▶ utility knife
- ▶ plastic dropcloth
- ▶ straightedge or yardstick
- cutting mat
- ▶ two 1" wood screws
- ▶ drill and drill bits
- > stand to attach the carpet tube on

Cut the carpet tube to 7 feet (or shorter, depending on the height of your ceiling). Wrap the carpet tube with black paper or paint it black.

Use scissors to cut out the four sections of the railroad crossing sign, leaving a white border.

Attach each section of the railroad crossing signs to the foam core with spray adhesive.

Cut out the sections with a utility knife.

Hot glue the words "Railroad" and "Crossing" in an "X," making sure "Railroad" is under "Crossing." Using the drill and wood screws, attach the "X" approximately 6 inches from the top of the carpet tube.

Stand the carpet tube upright, and secure in a stand.
