



## Encouragement Helps

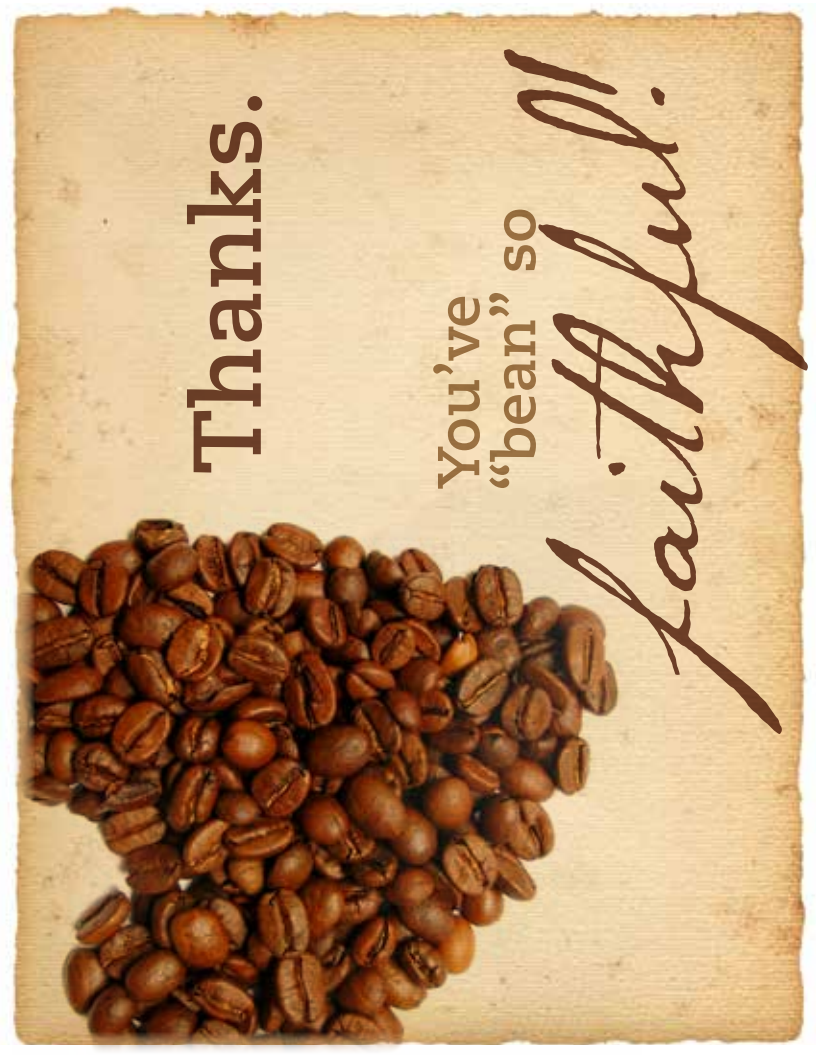
People serve for many reasons, such as obligation, thankfulness, or to use their gifts. They keep serving because they feel encouraged and appreciated!

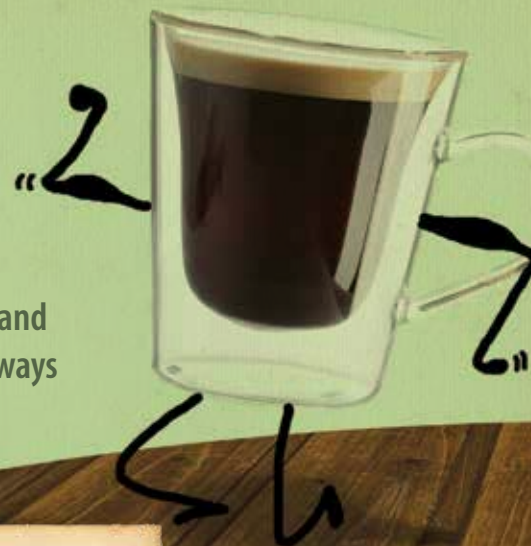
