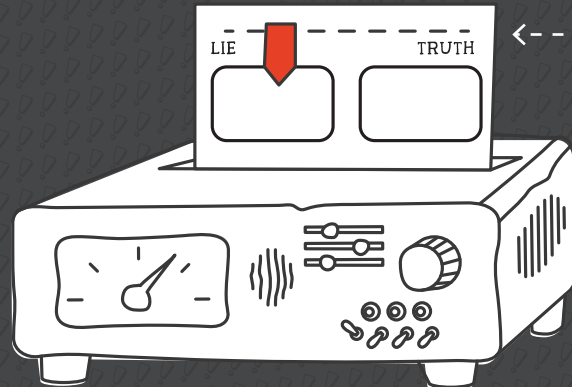
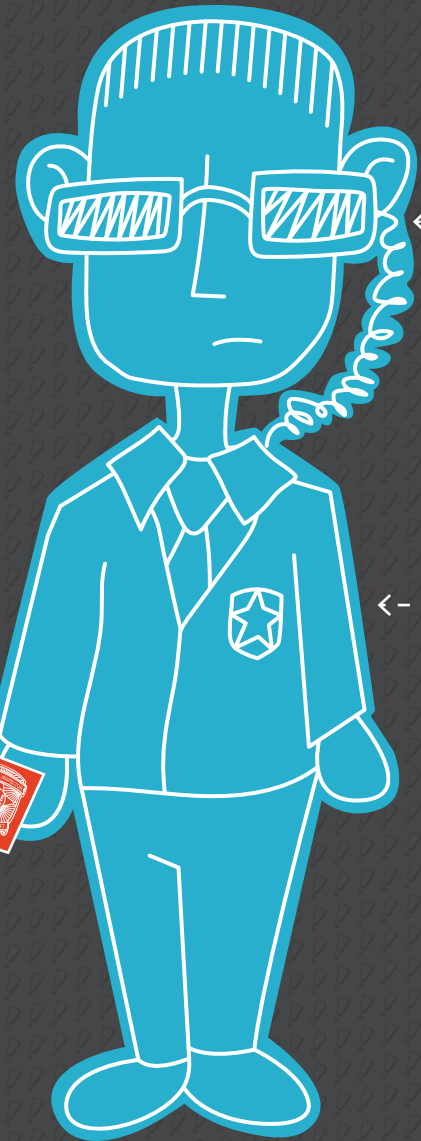

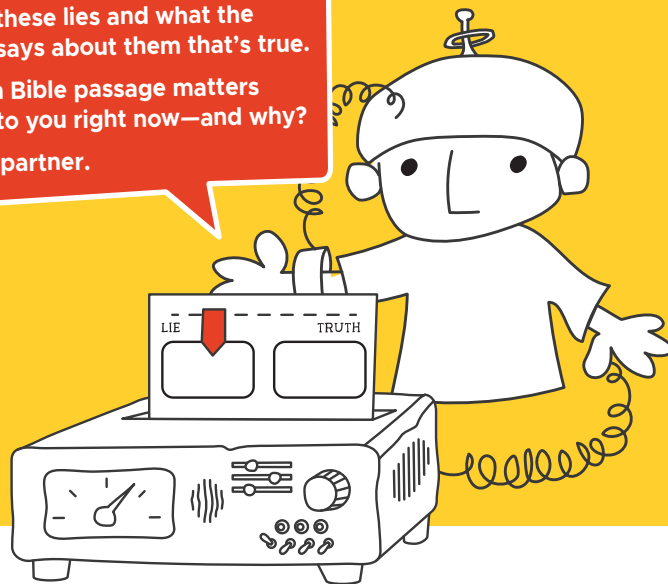

LIE DETECTOR

Some lies other people tell us.
Some lies we tell ourselves.
If you think these lies are true,
read the Bible passages for the truth!

Read these lies and what the Bible says about them that's true.
Which Bible passage matters most to you right now—and why?

LIE: “I’m a loser.”

TRUTH: You may have setbacks, but in the *big* stuff, you’re a winner! It’s all going to work out!

“But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Corinthians 15:57).

LIE: “Nobody loves me.”

TRUTH: Actually, God himself loves you. Not only that, but God *likes* you and wants to be your friend!

“For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16).

LIE: “Life is hopeless.”

TRUTH: There’s always hope—because there’s always help in Jesus. Lean on him for help!

“Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise him again—my Savior and my God!” (Psalm 43:5).

LIE: “I’m all alone.”

TRUTH: No, you aren’t. God is with you even when times get hard. *Especially* when times get hard!

“Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me. Your rod and your staff protect and comfort me” (Psalm 23:4).

LIE: “I’m ugly.”

TRUTH: You’re God’s creation, handcrafted and unique. Celebrate that—you’re one of a kind!

“Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it” (Psalm 139:14).

LIE: “I can get away with *anything*.”

TRUTH: Maybe you got away with a few things and nobody noticed. But think what it’s doing to your character. And besides, someone *did* notice.

“Don’t be misled—you cannot mock the justice of God. You will always harvest what you plant” (Galatians 6:7).

LIE: “I give up. Why even try?”

TRUTH: Your problems may be big—but God’s bigger. And he hears you when you’re feeling defeated.

“The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed” (Psalm 34:17-18).

LIE: “I can’t change no matter how hard I try.”

TRUTH: Change is hard—but with God’s help, you can be changed from the inside out.

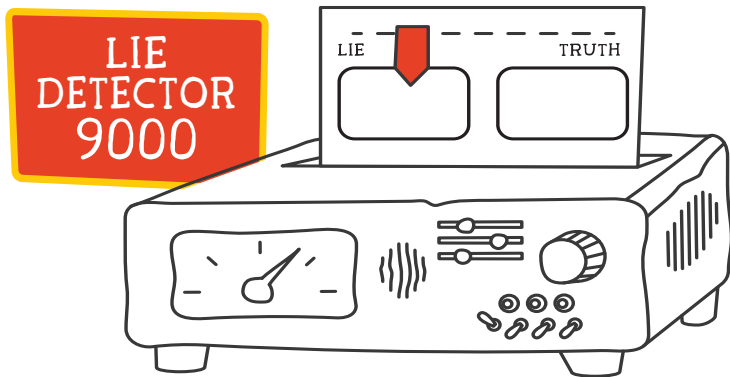
“Don’t copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think” (Romans 12:2).

LIE: “I’ll never forgive myself for what I did.”

TRUTH: Maybe you can’t, but God can. If you ask, you’ll find forgiveness from God—and he’ll help you forgive yourself, too. God is good at forgiveness.

“But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness” (1 John 1:9).
