

**TIP:** These windows are too heavy to tape to a wall, and you'll have much better luck hanging them from a drop ceiling rather than taping them to a wall.

## **Terrific Train Windows**

## Supplies

- ▶ 32"x40" sheet of white foam core
- ▶ Train Window Posters\*
- Weathered Wood Plastic Backdrop\*
- pencil
- scissors
- utility knife
- cutting mat
- clear packing tape
- ▶ yardstick
- scraps of Styrofoam or cardboard
- Magnetic Hooks\*
- ▶ fishing line

Lay one of the posters on the foam core. Trace around the poster, then use a utility knife to cut an opening in the foam core about an inch smaller than the outline you just traced to create a frame.

Wrap the frame with the Weathered Wood Plastic Backdrop.

Tape the poster to the back side of the frame so the poster faces out. Tape scraps of Styrofoam or cardboard to the back of the frame at

each corner to serve as spacers so the windows stand out from the wall just a bit.

Hang the frame from the ceiling using Magnetic Hooks and fishing line.
