All Aboard Timetable

Supplies

- ▶ 32"x40" piece of black foam core
- ▶ masking tape or colorful electrical tape
- ▶ Rocky Railway logo from the Giant Decorating Poster Pack*
- scissors
- yardstick
- ▶ pencil
- ▶ chalk marker
- green paint
- paintbrush
- ▶ dropcloth
- plastic gloves (optional; to protect hands while painting)
- ▶ 16"x48" cardboard sheet (or recycle a flat box from a bicycle, large TV, or assemble-it-yourself furniture)
- utility knife
- cutting mat
- ▶ hot glue gun and glue sticks
 - @ Paint the cardboard green. Allow time for it to dry.

Measure and cut the painted cardboard into 4-inch x 48-inch strips to create the frame.

Use the yardstick and pencil to divide the black foam core into rows and columns as described below:

12" x 12" 16" x 12" 12" x 12" 12" x 10" 16" x 10" 12" x 10" 12" x 10" 12" x 10"

Cover the pencil marks with masking tape or colorful electrical tape.

Use the chalk marker to write in timetable details. On ours we wrote "Train #," "Destination," and "Departure Time." You can customize yours as desired.

Hot glue the green cardboard pieces around the edges of the foam core to create a frame, trimming off the excess length as necessary.

Attach the Rocky Railway sign and the Rocky Railway logo from the Giant Decorating Poster Pack or print one from the Clip Art & Resources CD.



Tip: You'll have some green paint leftover from the main set decorating.
