


Set up the *easel* by folding each side back 90° and securing sides with fold-down locking wing tabs.



Attach the **backdrop** to the **easel** with the upper 2 bolts only. The lower holes will be used in future steps.



Attach the *lower support* bracket by folding it into a rectangle and securing with one bolt to the bottom of the backdrop.



Attach the *upper support* bracket to the backdrop by folding as shown and securing with a bolt on each of the end flaps.



Attach the *upper temple* piece by folding the side flaps back 90° and pushing the lock tabs into the uppermost slots in the *backdrop*.



Attach the *lower temple* piece by setting into the rear slots of the *lower support* bracket. Then push the two lock tabs into the backdrop.

Place the *lion* piece into the front slots of the *lower* support bracket.



Connect the *lion's paw* by folding each side of the wing lock over and pressing into the slot.



Place 2-sided Velcro squares on all the corresponding marks on the *Babylon sign*. There are 17 squares total.



Using the artwork shadows as a guide, adhere each of the *Babylon letters* to the Velcro squares on the *Babylon sign*.



Attach the *Babylon sign* with 2 bolts to the *upper support* bracket and 1 bolt to the *lower support bracket*.



Finally, position the *lion's*paw in the slot on the
Babylon sign. The finished
display can be used standing
up, or the bottom part of the
easel torn off so the display
can be suspended from the
hanger holes in the back.
